STUDY SHEET #2 – “How we should live as Catholics”

NOTE: There are no multiple choice, matching or fill in the blank questions on Test #2.

The Two Great Commandments:

1. You shall love the Lord your God with your whole mind, with your whole soul, and with all your heart.
2. Love your neighbor as yourself.

Ten Commandments: Be able to write the 10 Commandments (**Exodus 20:1-17**). (10 pts.)

1. I am the Lord your God. You shall not have strange gods besides me.
2. You shall not take the name of the Lord, your God, in vain.
3. Remember to keep holy the Sabbath Day.
4. Honor your father and your mother.
5. You shall not kill.
6. You shall not commit adultery.
7. You shall not steal.
8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor
9. You shall not covet your neighbor's spouse.
10. You shall not covet anything that belongs to your neighbor.

The Beatitudes (from the Sermon on the Mount – Matt 5:3-10): Fill in the blanks with 8 words given: comforted, merciful, heart, persecution, children, spirit, land, justice (8 pts.)

1. Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
2. Blessed are the meek; for they shall inherit the land.
3. Blessed are they that mourn; for they shall be comforted.
4. Blessed are they that hunger and thirst for justice; for they shall have their fill.
5. Blessed are the merciful; for they shall obtain mercy.
6. Blessed are the clean of heart; for they shall see God.
7. Blessed are the peacemakers; for they shall be called the children of God.
8. Blessed are they that suffer persecution for justice' sake; for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Corporal works of mercy:

- Feed the hungry
- Give drink to the thirsty
- Clothe the naked
- Visit the imprisoned
- Shelter the homeless
- Visit the sick
- Bury the dead.

Spiritual works of mercy:

- Counsel the doubtful
- Instruct the ignorant
- Admonish the sinner
- Comfort the sorrowful
- Forgive injuries
- Bear wrongs patiently
- Pray for the living and the dead

Precepts of the Church: (Duties of a Catholic) Be able to list these:

1. To keep holy the day of the Lord.
2. To lead a sacramental life.
3. To study Catholic teaching in preparation for Confirmation, and then to continue to study and advance the cause for Christ.
4. To observe marriage laws of the Church.
5. To strengthen and support the Church.
6. To do penance.
7. To join in the missionary spirit and apostolate of the Church.
