Key Takeaways

- The parish council is seeking to fill three open positions: Vice Chair, Secretary, and At-Large Representatives
- St. Patrick's Garage Sale was successful with good volunteer turnout; some security/pricing issues arose after some buyers removed tags; will gather input from volunteers to share suggestions and ways to improve the process.
- Several facility upgrades completed including sound system, atrium construction for our growing "Catechesis of the Good Shepherd", in addition to repairs and restriping for the east and west parking lots.
- New initiatives planned: Monthly Food Club events, Veterans Day Display, and engaging youth participation at Mass and encouraging children of the parish to contribute non-perishable food during the offertory collection.

Opening & Approval of Minutes

- Fr. K opened with a prayer.
- Minutes from the June 12th meeting were approved following Andy P's clarification that the Men's Club "Pasta Dinner", will be Tuesday January 24, 2026.

Topics

Update on Archdiocese "Capital Campaign" - Fr. K

- Met at Pastoral Center and provided an overview but not much information.
- Financial Goal has been set for St. Patrick's Parish and to start in January of 2026, not much time for planning. Will need more information related to identifying volunteers, contacting parishioners, emails, etc. More details in October.

St. Patrick's Capital Needs - Fr. K:

- Mechanicals (e.g. Furnace/Air Conditioner replacements, not IF but WHEN...
 ~\$312K and fire panel replacement \$5.8K); Patching and redoing sidewalks with
 cracks (~\$55K); 2020 endowment fund (~\$154K) with disbursement limited to
 4%/year; security system (many windows throughout the church campus)...
 strategies are being considered for improvements of safety.
- Met with Edina Police Dept. following Annunciation Parish shooting; we have many windows and 30 doors; changing all locks.

Events & Fundraisers

• Fall Fundraisers (October 18th and 25th) have been postponed due to staff time and lack of volunteers. Planning to recruit team leaders in January 2026 to plan for a Gala Event in December 2026.

Parish Council Recruitment - Terry K

- Three open positions need to be filled ASAP: Vice Chair, Secretary, and At-Large Representative
 - Difficulty recruiting younger members due to family commitments;
 considering mid-life parishioners who may be more available and engaged.
 - Suggestion made to explore recent parish graduates of the Catechetical Institute as potential candidates.

Faith Formation Update Fr. K

- Over thirty children currently enrolled in the "Catechesis of the Good Shepherd" (CGS) programs.
- We have only five 8th grade students for Confirmation this year and will again be partnering with Our Lady of Grace (OLG) for Confirmation preparation.
- New initiative: 7:15 AM Youth Mass at St. Patrick's on the fourth Tuesday of each month, for all Edina High and Middle School students, followed by donuts and beverages before classes begin.

Garage Sale Recap – Fr. K/Terry K

- One of the larger volunteer turnouts prior to and during the garage sale, but significantly short-staffed on the last day of the sale (Saturday afternoon) for teardown, tables, and clothing racks back to storage, and post-sale cleanup.
- Final financial results will be released when expenses and bank balances are finalized.
- Some security issues identified with theft and tag tampering
- Suggestions for improvement:
 - Dedicated setup day for tables
 - Better security/monitoring strategies
 - Photo catalog of high-value items
 - Special pre-sale for local first responders

- Ignatian Spirituality Series in October (\$20/person)
- Second Friday Hospitality each month after Mass

Men's Club Updates - Andy P

- Fence painting project on September 20th.
